

Rules for Outdoor Prayer Event

We will be offering our congregation an outdoor service of morning prayer from 9:00–9:45 a.m. on the front lawn of Truro.

- The congregation is invited to gather on the grass lawn (with space on the brick patio reserved for those needing wheelchair access), bringing their own chairs and/or blankets, and staying at least six feet away from anyone not in their family circle. Once the lawn is full, people will be invited to join from their car.
- Please plan to arrive early, beginning at 8:30. When you arrive please check in at the blue Welcome Tent, remaining 6 feet apart from others in line.
- Friendly members of staff will help you find a spot to set up your chairs/blankets. We ask that you maintain social distancing with during these interactions. Once you are seated, please do not move to a different spot unless directed by a member of staff.
- Bathrooms in the parish office building will be available in the case of emergencies. A Truro staff member will be positioned near the locked office door to permit one family/individual in at a time. The office and bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized before and after the service. Everyone, 10 and older are required to wear masks indoors.
- The service liturgy will be available for download, and you are encouraged to access the liturgy on your own handheld device. The service liturgy will be available on you weekly Tmail.
- In the event of rain, the service will be cancelled. In that case, a cancellation announcement will be made by 7:00 a.m. that day on the Truro website.
- Following the service, consecrated wafers will be available for individuals and families to take home, so they can participate in the live stream Communion service at 11:15 as usual.
- Masks are encouraged but not required outdoors.
