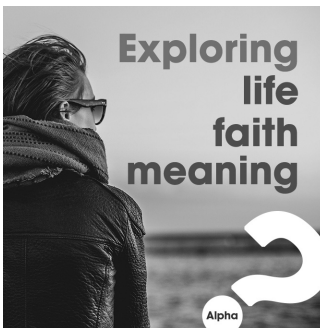


You Must Register in Advance for Rooted!

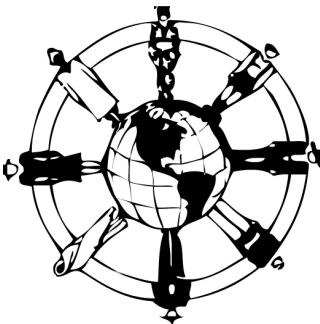
Everyone Can Support Alpha

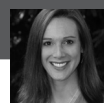
