Adult Confirmation

If you have never been confirmed in the Anglican Church, you can do so on Sunday, April 19. Confirmation is an affirmation of baptismal vows and is a required step for anyone wishing to step further into Truro leadership.

People come to Truro from all kinds of backgrounds, and some have been confirmed in other denominations. If this is you, you can be what is called "received" into the Anglican church.

Here are the steps to follow if you would like to be confirmed or received:

1. Fill out the confirmation form, available at bit.ly/truro-confirmation.
2. Take the 4-session Membership Class (offered 2-3 times per year. The next class begins Sun, Feb 2 at 10:30 am).
3. Take the 3-session Anglican Essentials class (also offered 2-3 times per year. Begins Sun, Mar 1 at 10:30 am).
4. Write a spiritual autobiography.

These steps can be taken in any order.
