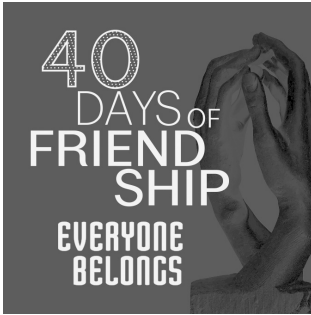

Wesley Hill, Assistant Professor of New Testament at Trinity School for Ministry, will be kicking off our "40 Days of Friendship" with the Lenten Teaching Mission on Sat, Feb 13. He will speak from his personal experience and his book, *Spiritual Friendship*, a Christianity Today Book of the Year: "In a time when we face a crisis of loneliness—Mother Teresa called it 'the greatest disease in the West'—Hill casts a powerful vision of Christian friendship as alluring as it is faithful. Weaving together theology, church history, and his own experience as a celibate gay Christian, the book

Annual Meeting and Vestry Election

The Annual Parish Meeting is coming soon. At that meeting, the congregation will select seven new members of the Truro Vestry. You will be able to meet the candidates for Vestry on the two Sundays prior to the Annual Meeting.

To be eligible to vote in the vestry election, a parishioner must be an adult communicant (16 years or older) in good standing and listed on the Truro Parish Register. To be a communicant in good standing, a person must be baptized, and for the previous year, faithful in worship (unless prevented for good cause), and faithful in working, praying, and giving for the spread of the Kingdom of God. To be listed on the Truro Parish Register, one of the following criteria must be met: have a signed Truro membership form on file or have a record of confirmation on file.

Even if you have been participating at Truro for some time, it is possible that your records were never formally updated. So, if you have not voted before or are uncertain about your eligibility to vote at this year's meeting, please contact Parish Secretary, Jeremy Lamb, jlamb@truroanglican.com or 703.273.1300 x115, to ensure your status is accurately reflected.
