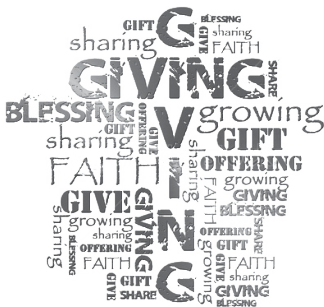

Journey the Way of the Cross

Each year before Easter, we journey symbolically for 40 days through the season of Lent.
