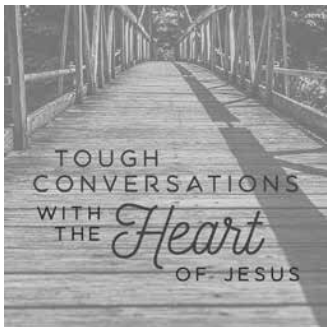

## SPTC Saturday Teaching in Lent: Christ and the Order of Love

Truro is offering a special SPTC series of classes on Saturday mornings in Lent. What might the person of Christ, human marriage, the orders of creation and redemption, and peacemaking have to do with each other? In this course, we will examine love and hate in terms of both the internal, subjective sense and the external, objective form, in light of the person of Jesus Christ and human nuptial love. We will also examine the paradigms of love and hate that are expressed in the Biblical account of creation, fall, and redemption, and how these relate to our concrete human experience.
