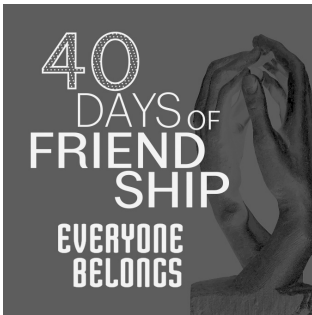


## Join Us for the 2016 Parish Retreat with Christopher West

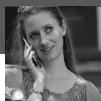
