Here are the steps to follow if you would like to be confirmed or received:

1. Fill out the confirmation form, available at bit.ly/truro-confirmation.
2. Take the 4-session Membership Class, offered 2-3 times per year.
3. Take the 3-session Anglican Essentials class, also offered 2-3 times per year. Begins next Sun, Mar 1 at 10:30 am.
4. Write a spiritual autobiography.

These steps can be taken in any order.
