Truro Annual Meeting

Plan to be at Truro's annual meeting to hear about the vision for Truro's future. We'll also be voting for new vestry members. "Vestry" is a good old Anglican word for the body at Truro that functions as our board of directors. Our vestry has 18 members who serve three-year terms. Six new vestry members will be elected during this meeting to replace the six whose terms are expiring. Only Truro members can vote in the vestry election. The 9:00 service that day will end promptly at 10:00, and the meeting will immediately follow, ending in time for the 11:15 service.

You Can Now Give to Truro Via Text!

Truro has a new giving method—texting! It's a simple process—even easier after you do it once, since the system will remember you. So how does it work?

1. You MUST use a smartphone.
2. Text the word "Truro" to 73256 and the amount you want to give (e.g., to give \$5, you would text "Truro 5").
3. Click the link that you receive in the return text.
4. Input your information: choose the fund (PLEDGE is the name of the fund—see #6 below), amount, and payment information (you can use a debit or credit card, or provide your bank information).
5. You will receive a receipt from the system.
6. Please note that Truro has only ONE FUND in the system, called "PLEDGE," which is what we call our General Fund. Giving to the Pledge fund does not mean that you are giving toward a pledge or that you turned in a pledge card—only that your giving will be to the General Fund.
