Canon Andrew White Named Honorary Rector of Reconciliation at Truro Anglican

Last week the Vestry voted unanimously to appoint Canon Andrew White as the Honorary Rector of Reconciliation at Truro Anglican Church. In addition to hosting Andrew twice a year, Truro will also be the North American site of his Jerusalem International School of Reconciliation (JISR). This initiative, along with our St. Paul's Theology Centre (SPTC) "DC Theology Hub" and The Amore Project, will be a cornerstone in our emerging Peacemaking Community. We will explain more about that on May 29 when Andrew is installed at Truro. In preparation for our Annual Meeting I was able to ask

Andrew a few questions about this appointment and why he was eager to come to work with us in the vital gospel work of Reconciliation.

Tory: Andrew, it is a great honor to have you here at Truro. You have been a friend to Tim and me (the Rector and his associate) for some years. What do you see in this development of our friendship? How do you hope God will bless others through this deeper collaboration?

Andrew: I think that this is a very important development. My relationship with Tory is outstanding, as it is with Tim Mayfield, who worked for me many years ago when I was a Vicar in London. I hope that in this relationship we can see how we can work at reconciliation at a broader level, not only in the Middle East, but in America as well.

Tory: There is much confusion about reconciliation work. What do you hope to pass on to Truro, the Anglican and Episcopal Churches as well as the greater DC community through this partnership?

Andrew: The most important lesson that we have learned is connected to the question: "who is my enemy?" As the saying goes, the answer to this question is that "my enemy is the person whose story I have not truly heard." Therefore I trust and hope that Truro may be a place where their enemies can truly come and tell their stories. This indeed is what Tory stands for.

Tory: This is a five year appointment as "Honorary Rector of Reconciliation." What do you hope will be different in the greater Church in DC and beyond because of this collaboration?

Andrew: In a Church which has suffered much brokenness, we trust and hope that we may be able to show that we are indeed about bringing restoration and reconciliation.

In addition to his installation on Sun, May 29, Andrew will be teaching Saturday morning, May 28 at our SPTC Theology Hub on the subject of "The Biblical Theology of Reconciliation." Registration details will be forthcoming.

Please plan to be present at this Sunday's Annual Meeting, Mar 6 at 2:00 pm, as the Rector discusses Truro's new chapter in its pioneering work of reconciliation and peacemaking.
