The annual meeting of Truro Anglican Church, including the election of four new vestry members, will start at 10:00 am next Sunday, March 15, in the Sanctuary. Judges will distribute one ballot to each eligible voter whose name appears on the list beginning at 8:00 am that day and ending at such time as the marked ballots are being collected to be counted. Eligible voters need to present themselves in person in Common Grounds to pick up ballots. Bringing proper photo identification (e.g., driver's license) is strongly recommended. Proxy voting by eligible voters is prohibited.

The list of eligible voters is available for inspection and correction until the scheduled start time of the annual meeting. After the time period for inspection and correction closes, the list of eligible voters is final.

Our parking lot will be full next Sunday because of the meeting. Please consider parking across the street in the Bank of America parking lot or next door at the Mosby Building.
