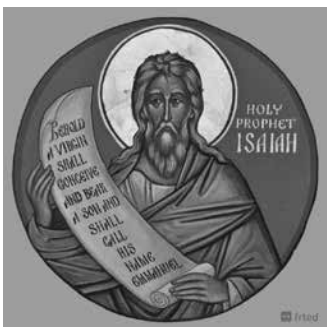


Next Weekend: Canon Andrew White Visiting
