Regarding Coronavirus

As we go to press with this publication on Friday, March 13 at 9:00 am, we continue to closely monitor medical recommendations and consult with our diocese regarding how to take care of our congregation, including how to protect you when you're here at Truro. Here are some changes you will notice at today's services:

- We are not shaking hands at the Peace or when the clergy greet you as you enter and leave.
- The offering plates are not being passed from hand to hand. Please drop your offering in one of the plates when you come forward for Communion.
- We are offering only bread and not wine during Communion. Please be assured that receiving only the bread is understood by the Church to be fully receiving Holy Communion.

We are doing everything we can to make this campus as safe and clean as possible. We are disinfecting common areas between services, including the pew backs where everyone places their hands. As always, the kids areas are meticulously and frequently cleaned.

Please, if you or anyone in your family feels ill or has a fever in the 24 hours before Sunday morning, stay home and take care of yourselves. Please continue to wash your hands thoroughly and frequently. And be sure to let us know how we can pray for you and be helpful to you or others you know.
