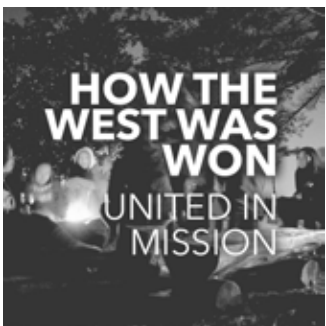


"Liberate Local" Concert Coming to Truro
