Try a Community Group for Seven Weeks This Spring!

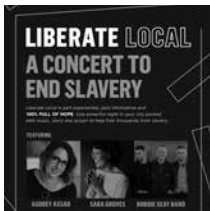

How the West Was Won | May 10-12 | Shrine Mont

Dear Truro Family,

Recently our daughters have been getting together with different sides of the Tyndall-Baucum clan. They have done this without our urging or permission. It's natural for all of us to simply "want to be with family." In just this year, I have counted five such get-togethers. As our daughters enter into young adulthood, they seem to need to get their collective bearings and grounding before stepping further out into their individual journeys.

Likewise, Christianity itself is a family of families. Many families of all sorts and sizes comprise the family of Truro. In addition, the family of Truro is part of a larger Anglican family of churches. When the extended family of Anglicanism comes together—either in synod meetings or the Lambeth Conference—we get a sense of the depth and diversity of our family, in our case 80 million strong in 39 international provinces.

Yet, Anglicanism is not the only family of churches to which we belong. All those who follow Jesus and who seek communion with others who follow Jesus are also "family." In John 17, Jesus specifically prayed for these who believe in him that they "all would be one as he and the Father are one." Because of Jesus' prayer, we are spiritually obligated to seek out unity with all those who follow Jesus. They too are our family.

Truro's ecumenical retreat at Shrine Mont is one small, practical way our parish seeks to implement Jesus' own prayer and vision for his people, the Church. We want more unity with our brothers and sisters in Christ—whether they be Baptist, Catholic, Orthodox, or whatever. It's natural that we should want to be with each other. After all, we are family. And Jesus is praying for our greater unity. So come and share being in unity with family.
