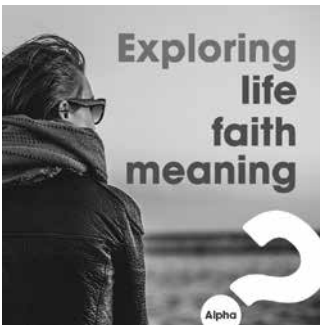
Find Your Place at Truro This Spring

Genesis 2019 is on the horizon! We can't wait to host hundreds of children again for this fun, highly interactive, week-long day camp. Genesis is for kids PreK (ages 3-5, must be potty trained) and Elementary (rising K to rising 5th grade). Genesis runs from 9:00 am-12:30 pm each day and costs only \$75 for the week. Each morning begins with a high-energy large group session, complete with characters, music, and a lesson, before kids are dismissed in age groups to various classes with paid local art teachers.

We also offer a limited number of extended care spots for elementary-aged kids from 12:30-3:30 pm for \$25/day. Extended care includes games, crafts, and more under the supervision of trained and background-checked teens and adults. All proceeds will go to Truro's Youth Ministry.

April was an amazing month at Truro! We celebrated Holy Week and Easter Sunday with incredible numbers. It was simply glorious. Many thanks to everyone involved in making this such a powerful time in the life of our parish. Our TIPS ministry had a big picnic at Burke Lake with 140 in attendance. We hosted a powerful concert in support of the International Justice Mission (IJM) to stop slavery. We sold 620 tickets, and it was a wonderful evening that generated a great deal of support for this important ministry. We had 70 attend a launch for Brad Littlejohn's wonderful book about Anglican pioneer Richard Hooker. Our Men's Ministry had 50+ men attend a powerful breakfast gathering, a great time of prayer and fellowship. Truro's clergy went on a very special retreat together following Easter. José Garrigó joined in an interfaith walk and was able to share the Gospel with the crowd of visitors. All this plus we are continuing our efforts to promote dialogue with the African American Christian community through the soon-to-be released film *Emanuel*, a documentary on the 2015 church shooting in Charleston (much more on this to follow). Can't wait for all May has in store for Truro!
