They are available on the left side of the Communion rail. Please request one, and we will gladly serve you from a separate plate.

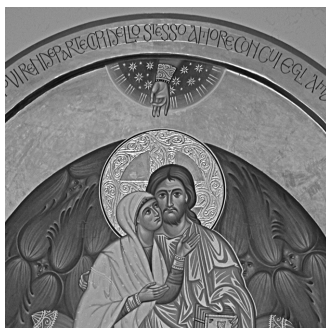


Signs of Love Webinar

On this mission trip, we will be providing marriage and youth ministry support. We will provide training for the Marriage Course and a “Seminar On Marriage” to 10 churches and will conduct a Marriage retreat for couples who serve in pastoral leadership. We will also be developing a day camp for teens and young adults, and have a goal of devising a plan for a shared day camp with the churches in Guantánamo for the next five years.

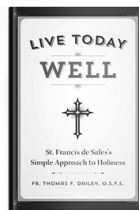
