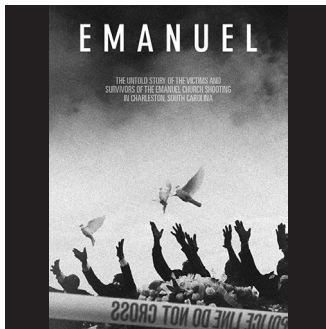
Kids Stuff

We'll be back next week with KidZone during the 9:00 + 11:15 services, and Kids Half Time in between those services.

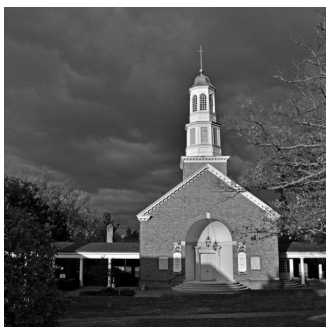
The nursery is open for kids up to 48 months.

In the coming weeks, we will be talking more about a film called *Emanuel*, which tells the story of the 2015 shooting at Emanuel AME Church in Charleston and its aftermath. Truro is partnering with two other local churches—New Hope Church and Antioch Baptist Church—for a special screening on Wednesday, June 12. The film's official showing in theaters is on June 17 and June 19. Everyone at Truro is encouraged to attend one of these screenings and to enter into the conversation about the challenging grace and forgiveness evidenced by the shooting victims and their families. The film will be foundational to our teaching as we head into the fall.
