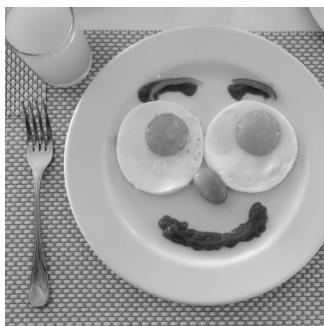


## One Week from Today: Youth Water Night!
