And the commitment of those volunteers is what has enabled TIPS to have a vibrant ministry during the past year.

When we enroll internationals in our ESL classes, we are not offering just first-class English lessons, but also classes in American Culture and Exploring Faith. American Culture includes topics ranging from American weddings to rights of the disabled. This year's well-attended Exploring Faith class was a natural lead-in to the summer Alpha ESOL classes happening now.



When we welcome our internationals to classes, TIPS also commits to walking alongside them as they face

life struggles. Whether supporting them through a dire diagnosis after a prenatal ultrasound (with a miraculous outcome!) or dying parents overseas, volunteers offer prayer support and practical help.

This year, TIPS also provided fun activities for families: Thanksgiving dinner, Christmas tree trimming party, family Valentines dinner, movie matinee, spring picnic at Burke Lake, and an ice cream social. Our annual field trips include Mount Vernon, worship at Antioch Baptist Church, the Udvar Hazy Center, Lancaster, PA, and the D.C. Cherry Blossoms.



TIPS activities that became part of our core program in 2018 include providing lunches for 60 students between morning and afternoon classes, Little TIPS preschool during classes, and The House (a time of Bible storytelling, conversation, and prayer with dinner). TIPS participates in Truro worship services through Prayers of the People, our Pentecost celebration, and regular attendance of TIPS students.

Inaugural programs this year with enthusiastic participation included driving classes, a mom's nursing program, and individual prayer offered by the TIPS prayer team.

The summer is also a vibrant time for TIPS students and volunteers. We have One-to-One Conversation Partners and
