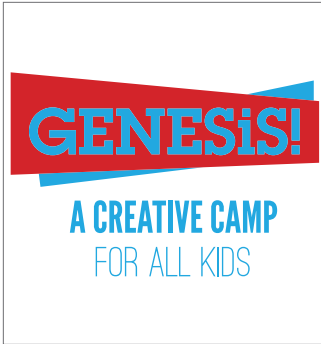

This happens with people we know already, but we are also thrown together with people we might not otherwise talk to! At picnics, we practice "lov(ing) one another with [familial] affection" (Romans 12:10), breaking-down stodgy stereotypes and fear of the unknown in a relaxed, "family-like" environment.
