Thank you for praying us into Cuba, sustaining us during ministry and bringing us back. We experienced spiritual resistance from the very beginning; however, God gave us peace through every obstacle. Our ministry there has been successful in all ways and has opened an opportunity to be able to grow into blessing the Cuban church and people in general. Our ministry consisted of praying and visiting individuals; preaching in three churches; teaching children, adolescents, men and women; helping with goods like hygiene, clothing, books, musical equipment, computers; giving hope; bringing joy; and, most important, sharing our lives with our Cuban brothers and sisters. We also conducted a Parenting Course seminar during three three-hour sessions to leaders from nine churches. Through this writing, we transmit a deep and loud "Gracias" from the churches in Guantánamo who are expecting us again next year for Marriage Course training.

RECIPE

Chicken with Lemon Herb Salad Dressing

Buy or bake 3 small chickens. Chickens can be baked a day ahead. If you are baking them yourself, sprinkle with salt and pepper, stuff chicken with one sliced lemon and fresh thyme. Bake at 450° F for approximately 1 hour.

INGREDIENTS

4 bags fresh arugula
Fresh Lemon Herb Salad Dressing (see below)

DIRECTIONS

Cut the chickens up in eight pieces. Cut the breast into two pieces. Spread lettuce over a big platter, dress with Lemon Herb Salad Dressing. Place chicken pieces on top of lettuce and it's ready to serve. More chicken, more lettuce for more people.

Lemon Herb Salad Dressing

INGREDIENTS

1 1/2 tsp Dijon mustard
4 Tbsp lemon juice
2 tsp red wine vinegar
1 1/2 cups extra-virgin olive oil
1 1/2 Tbsp fresh chopped parsley
1 1/2 Tbsp fresh chopped basil, chives, and/or tarragon
1/8 tsp salt or to taste

DIRECTIONS

In a small jar with a tight-fitting lid, combine all the ingredients. Cover and shake vigorously. Season to taste with freshly ground pepper.
