Truro announced the launch of the Truro Institute, an ecumenical peacemaking initiative that will initially focus on racial reconciliation and on solidarity between Jews and Christians. As part of this vision, we worked with a number of African American partner churches for private screenings of the movie *Emanuel*, which filled two theaters. When the movie officially premiered later in the month, the theaters were again full. This effort culminated with an event called "Emanuel Conversation," led by José Garrigó and others, a powerful time of sharing.
