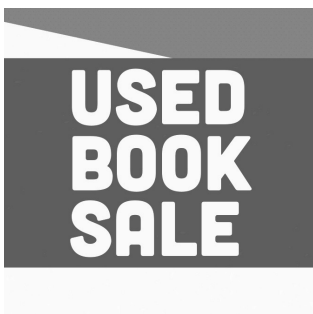

RECIPE

Chicken Salad for a Crowd

INGREDIENTS

1 cup chopped walnuts
6 cups chopped cooked chicken
(can use 2 chickens from the deli)
2 cups seedless red grapes, halved
2 large Gala apple, diced
1 cup golden raisins
2 cups diced celery
1 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup honey mustard
Salt and pepper to taste

Optional: add 2 Tbsp curry (or to taste) to mayonnaise. Combine all ingredients, mix and serve. Serves 12.

We recently had the opportunity to travel to Italy to attend the 6th National Mistero Grande conference put on by Don Renzo Bonetti. Along with several other Truro members, we went to learn more about nuptial theology and how our marriages are a sign of God's love for the entire world, and how we can be expressions of the domestic church.

The entire experience was a tremendous blessing to our marriage!
