Is More Than 100% possible? Yes it is! Report on Guantánamo 2017

All the goals of our mission trip to Guantánamo were accomplished, and more.

Eighteen suitcases full of materials and practical help were taken to palliate the needs of eight churches, including medicine, clothing, hygienic items, soccer balls, shoes, and backpacks.

We supplied our sister church with electric appliances for the kitchen, utensils, silverware (200 units), a projector and speakers, 20 sets of sheets for a hostel, and 12 towels. We donated eight cellphones, one tablet, and two computers. We provided 60 Marriage Course manuals, 15 DVD sets, and eight marriage books.

We trained eight churches to run the Marriage Course and gave three days of teaching on marriage; took 10 couples on a two-day marriage retreat; prepared multiple activities with youth and young adults; planned a summer camp for next year; preached in five different gatherings; prayed for many; saw God work in multiple ways; and made a lot of friends.
