Folks, July was an incredible month. Tory led a truly formative pilgrimage of four young adults to Poland that profoundly impacted the group and laid the groundwork for additional pilgrimages. Summer Worship Nights have been a wonderful time of fellowship, worship, and prayer. Our Cuba Global Alpha Team (GAT) saw changes since their earlier visits—churches growing through Alpha, youth groups of 30 kids where before there were none—amazing fruit. Over 2,000 folks from our community attended the City of Fairfax-Truro production of *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat*, bringing together many from our community. We hosted a number of important Diocese of the Mid-Atlantic (DOMA) events at Truro that were highly impactful. Truro Young Adults completed a wonderful Bible study. Jim Wilkinson and the Truro Garden Club, working alongside Eagle Scouts from Truro Troop 918, raised over \$7,000 in support of their beautification campaign, while completing yet another gorgeous “makeover” near our historic chapel, complete with another beautiful memorial bench. Senior lunches have had record numbers of attendees. The TIPS 1-on-1 program continues to have big impact. And finally, our Truro Youth took off on the last Sunday of the month for an incredible mission trip to Philadelphia! Can't wait to see what August brings!
