TODAY: Parish Picnic

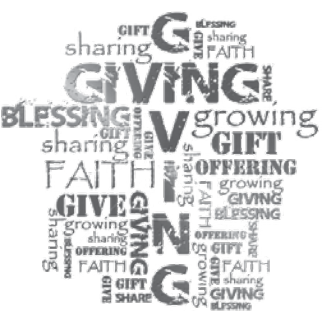
