Fortunately for you, we have a plethora of opportunities (61, to be exact!) for you to learn to love like God by loving children at Truro. We are currently in need of adults and/or teenagers to serve in the following ways:

Kids Ministry. **Small group leaders** during the 9:00 am (4) and 11:15 am (6) services (weekly commitment); **Teachers** (8) to teach all year during our weekly Discipleship Hour (1 month at a time).

Wee Worship. **Leaders** (10) to teach or help teach our pre-schoolers (1x/month at one service); **Welcome desk volunteers** (10) to greet parents and children at the nursery (1x/month at one service).

Youth. **Small group leaders** (8, especially women) to build relationships with teenagers and help them explore and apply faith (weekly), Sun(s), 6:15 - 8:15 pm.

Squad 5-6. **Small group leaders** (1 guy, 2 women) to lead small groups for 5th and 6th graders (weekly), Wed(s), 5:00 - 6:00 pm,

Alpha. **Adults and/or teens** (12) to help run our Kids Olympics program (Fri(s) during Alpha this fall).
