### Parking Lot Spruce-Up Begins This Week

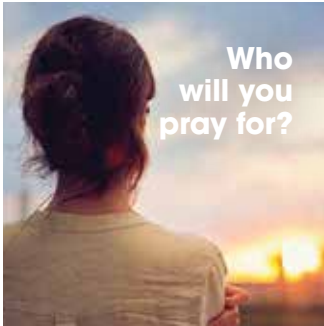
