Fortunately for you, 43 of our 68 opportunities are still available! We need adults and/or teenagers to serve in the following ways:

Kids Ministry. Small group leaders during the 9:00 am (2) and 11:15 am (4) services (weekly commitment); 2 room hosts for kids discipleship time, 10:30 am (weekly commitment).

Wee Worship. Leaders (4) to teach or help teach our pre-schoolers (1x/month at one service); **Welcome desk volunteers** (9) to greet parents and children at the nursery (1x/month at one service).

Youth. Small group leaders (8, especially women) to build relationships with teenagers and help them explore and apply faith (weekly), Sun(s), 6:15 - 8:15 pm.

Squad 5-6. Small group leaders (1 guy, 2 women) to lead small groups for 5th and 6th graders (weekly), Wed(s), 5:00 - 6:00 pm.

Alpha. Adults and/or teens (12) to help run our Kids Olympics program (Fri(s) during Alpha, starting Sep 30).
