

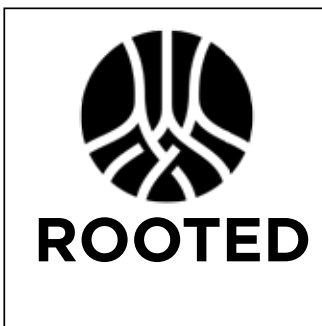
Today We Share Our Alpha Prayer Cards
