Wow, can you believe we are already three-quarters of the way through 2019?! Hard to believe, but it is true! One thing I like to do about once per quarter is to check my total giving to date, to be sure I am on track to meet my giving goals for Truro. A lot of us wait for statements to be mailed, but in reality there is no need to wait. It is very easy to check online. All you need to do is to go onto our website (or on InFellowship) and click on Giving. On our website, the Giving link is at the very top of the home page—once you click it, it actually takes you to your InFellowship account. If you log in directly to InFellowship, there is a tab on the left side of your screen called “Your Giving.” Click on that, and it takes you to the same giving page you get to via the Truro website. Either way, once there, you can see all of your giving year-to-date, previous years, whatever you need to view. It’s all easy to print out, if that is helpful to you.
