Campus Safety Improvements Continue

We continue to make upgrades to our beautiful campus! One very important area of improvement is campus safety. A new electronic key access system has been installed in the Education Building and in the Parish Office Building, with plans to add additional areas of the campus in later phases. Limited access to these buildings is a much-needed safety improvement, especially for our children in TPK. Going forward, the Education Building will only be open for scheduled events outside of TPK hours as well as Sunday mornings, and the Parish Office will only be open during regular business hours and for scheduled events. It is extremely important that these doors not be propped or left open or an alarm will sound. If you are a ministry leader and are concerned that you might not have the access that you need, please discuss your concerns with your respective staff contact. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we go through this transition.
