Family Ministries launched an all-new Sunday School and KidZone curriculum for our kids and, once again, Truro Youth has started strong, with record numbers of youth signed up—all that and a gorgeous new kids and youth tent to welcome visitors with children to Truro! Friday's Senior lunches started back up as well, with five new seniors attending. This wonderful ministry continues to grow, and in mid-September, Truro vans took 12 seniors to a Catholic monastery for a wonderful program—all who attended were thrilled. With your special giving, we have installed beautiful new room dividers in the Art Gallery and MOLO rooms downstairs in the Undercroft, providing additional useful spaces for kids programs, Alpha, etc. Adult choir started back up, with a number of new members, and they sound AMAZING! Can't wait to see what October brings!

How Do I Check My Giving to Truro?

I encourage you to do so as well—and if you find you have accidentally given too much, don't worry—God will pay you back!
