Truro's annual stewardship campaign kicks off this month. Your pledge cards represent your willingness to support the vision and mission of our church as we engage in ministry together. Folks at Truro are very faithful about keeping their pledges, because the pledge serves as a kind of financial covenant between you and God, an important step in our faith walk.

Your giving supports all of the vibrant ministry going on at Truro. This includes Sunday worship services, kids programs, youth opportunities, community groups, Alpha and Rooted, prayer and healing teams, and many resources to support marriages and families. We touch folks' lives at important milestones—baptism, confirmation, weddings, and funerals. Our preschool has a deep impact on the lives of children and families throughout our community. And our new peacemaking organization, the Truro Institute, will do much to bring together Christians who are black, white, and other races, as well as Jews and Christians.

The biblical standard for giving is to tithe 10% of whatever we have. Tithing is a goal for folks to aspire to. Many at Truro give 10% (or more), and many others give as they can. But however much you give, do so joyfully on November 3, when we will all be invited to come up during our worship service and place our pledge cards in a basket.

As stewardship season begins, find some quiet time and talk with your Lord. Focus your prayers on what you think you can do in 2020. Then listen to what he has to say, giving Jesus a chance to bless you through your faithful commitment to his kingdom. Be at peace. And never forget the words of Canon Andrew White, who was once asked what to do if you accidentally give God too much. He said: "Oh, don't worry about that, he will pay you back!"
