

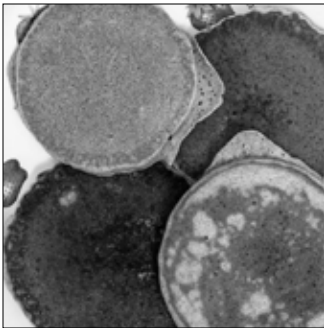


Celebrate Fall This Saturday with Truro + TPK
