Filling out the Pledge Card for 2020 by Bob Tate



Next Sunday is our annual stewardship Sunday, when we will fill out our pledge cards for 2020. For many long-time Truro parishioners, filling out the pledge card is

probably second nature. But for a lot of people, it is probably less clear. Everyone should have received a pledge card in the mail. There are cards stocked in the pews as well. The card has three sections, with two perforations. The blue section on the right is for you to keep as a reminder of your financial pledge to Truro for 2020. I keep mine in my checking ledger to remind me of my pledge throughout the year.

The other two parts are how you communicate your pledge for the year to us—one for your financial giving and the other for the giving of your time. The left section lets us know how much you plan to pledge financially. Please note that the amount that you indicate is your total giving for the year—you can actually give weekly, monthly, or however works best in your own budget, but please do the math and tell us what your total pledge will be for 2020. We will compile total pledges from all pledge cards, a key component in crafting our church budget in support of ministry efforts in 2020.

The section on giving your time is only useful if you give us your name and contact info, so please do that. If you want to keep your financial pledge confidential, tear off this second panel to keep it separate. And please tell us about NEW areas you'd like to join in 2020, not ones where you already serve.

You have the option of giving to Truro electronically. You can set up automatic giving on a recurring time frame (weekly, monthly, etc). You can give from a checking or savings account, or by using a debit or credit card. I have given electronically for several years, and I can tell you that it is super easy, safe, and ensures that the church receives my pledge even if I cannot attend on a given Sunday. The more folks do this, the steadier our income stream is. This minimizes disruptions to church operations, especially during the leaner summer months when many folks go away on vacation, or low Sundays in the winter due to poor weather. So please do consider online giving. No matter how you give, we are ever so grateful for your faithfulness to the Lord through your giving to our church and its many anointed ministries!
