Mark 6 reminds us that Jesus had no difficulty feeding 5,000 men (plus women and children!) with a mere five loaves and two fish. With Jesus, there is always more than enough to go around.

Thinking and acting as if this is actually true (because we believe that it is) has been transformational for us. We no longer give out of a feeling of scarcity or guilt, but out of a sense of abundance and generosity, trusting that, as we follow Jesus, there will always be more than enough. And you know what? There has been. There was always enough when we fundraised our salary and ministry budget with InterVarsity. There was always enough time to get dinner ready for the community groups we have led. God has always provided enough for us to take Jesus seriously when He says, "Give to the one who asks you" in Matthew 5. And even now, with two jobs, commutes, childcare, and all of the things that tempt us to believe that there isn't enough, God has continued to prove Himself faithful, providing for us generously and showing us how to, in turn, give our time and resources out of His abundance, rather than out of our own fear.
