Who Are All These People? Find Out with our Online Directory!

The Truro directory is part of our online congregational portal, InFellowship, so to access it, you need to have an account. If you don't have one yet, it's super easy to set up. Click the InFellowship link at the top of our website homepage or go to tacva.infellowship.com. Click on "Don't have an account? Sign Up." All you need to provide is your name and an email address.

To be able to see the Truro directory, you first have to manually add YOURSELF to the directory—accounts are not automatically included in the directory. Log in, and on the main page, click Privacy Settings. You have total control over who sees which pieces of your personal info. Whatever you designate for "Everyone" will appear in the directory. Drag the sliders on the graph to designate what info you want to share.

At the bottom of this page, in small type, there is a checkbox that says "Include me in the church directory." Click this box to appear in the directory AND to be able to view it.

Save your privacy settings, then click the link for the directory. You will immediately notice all the entries without photos! Photos are what make the directory useful. PLEASE upload a photo to your profile. How? Go to your profile page. Click the box next to your name and upload a headshot. Even easier: grab Karen Rummel if you see her (she has a photo in the directory!) and she can take a photo of you on the spot with her phone and immediately upload it.
