Tired of writing checks every week or every month? For next year, why not try our easy method to automatically take care of your pledge? You have two options: auto-deduct from your credit card of choice or direct charge to your bank account. In both cases, you will get a handy email that notifies you that an auto-deduction will be made, and a second email to tell you that the transaction was processed. This really helps us because it saves processing time and gives us a good estimate of cash flow. It helps you because you don't have to worry about mailing your pledge when you go out of town. ## How To Fill Out a Pledge Card

Your pledge card for 2018 has three panels to fill out:

Panel 1: Please select one of the three options at the top. At the bottom, choose only one timeframe (weekly or monthly, etc.), and enter the amount that you pledge to give in that timeframe.

Panel 2. Choose an area to which you would like to give time and talent. Include your contact information so the appropriate ministry can follow up with you.

Panel 3. Fill out your pledge information, and keep this panel for your own records.
