

Truro Anglican Church-Regular Vestry Meeting Summary

June 2026

The regular meeting of the Truro Anglican Church Vestry was called to order by Jamie Brown at **7:02 pm** on Tuesday, June 16, 2026.

Summary

Opening items

Jamie opened with prayer. He followed with a devotional reading from Colossians 1:3-9, focusing on Paul's prayer for the church to be filled with spiritual wisdom. After commenting on the text, Jamie led the vestry in an extended time of prayer for the needs of the congregation.

Initial Matters

- a) Consideration of the Agenda.
- b) The Vestry moved, seconded, and *approved* acceptance of the Vestry Meeting Minutes – April 19, 2026.

Financial Update

- Financial Summary Reports – May Finance Committee, TPK, and Trinity Burke. Treasurer Don Foy reported on:
 - a) Truro's finances for the month of May and a year-to-date summary
 - b) Truro's overall cash reserves and investments
 - c) Trinity Burke's finances for the month of May and a year-to-date summary
 - d) TPK's finances for the month of May and a year-to-date summary
- The Vestry moved, seconded, and approved acceptance of the financial reports.
- Jamie and other vestry members paused to offer prayers of thanksgiving for God's faithful provision, and for His provision in the future.

Ministry Update

- a) The vestry welcomed Chris Hammond, who shared his testimony regarding his transition from Presbyterian ministry to joining the Truro staff full-time. Chris expressed excitement for adult discipleship, specifically focusing on helping the congregation discern, mobilize, and engage their spiritual gifts. Looking ahead, he detailed the discernment process for his transition into the Anglican Church.
- b) Jamie and other vestry members paused to offer Chris prayers of thanksgiving for God's timing in bringing him to Truro.

Business

- a) A Decision Brief was presented by Don Foy for funding the Undercroft Flooring and Administration Office hallway carpet replacement. The Vestry voted to approve.
- b) A Decision Brief was presented by Don Foy, for approval of Trinity Burke's request to transfer their portion of operating cash from Truro's accounts to a designated Trinity Burke bank account, enabling them to assume direct control of their bookkeeping in preparation for independent status. The Vestry voted to approve.

Officer and Other Reports

- a) Director of Operations report- Daria Brown presented the operations and facilities update, focusing on property recovery, Synod updates, and staff wellness.
 - The education building is largely back to normal. Final drywall work, toilet re-installation, and cabinet replacement continue in the damaged classroom, which is on track for a full reopening this Fall.
 - Synod 2026 Planning (November 12–14): Planning continues to progress, with caterers, volunteers, and three large courtyard tents already secured. The staff continues to coordinate closely with the Diocese to ensure the success of the event.
 - Staff Wellness Update: Continued prayer was requested for the well-being of the staff.
- b) Senior Warden -No report submitted.
- c) Rector's Report- No report submitted.

The Vestry entered executive session at **8:25 pm** and ended at **8:36 pm**.
