

Truro Anglican Church-Regular Vestry Meeting Summary

July 2026

The regular meeting of the Truro Anglican Church Vestry was called to order by Jamie Brown at **7:02 pm** on Tuesday, July 21, 2026.

Summary

Opening items

Jamie opened with prayer. Turning to Psalm 92:1-2, he led the vestry in a time of reflection on God's steadfast love and faithfulness over the past ministry year, inviting members to share specific ways they have seen God at work across the parish. Following this time of thanksgiving, Jamie shared a prayer concern, and the vestry joined in an extended time of prayer for a former vestry member and their family during their time of grief.

Initial Matters

The Vestry moved, seconded, and approved acceptance of the Vestry Meeting Minutes – June 16, 2026, after amending the Financial Update to reflect a vestry request for a cash flow statement alongside the accrual-based report.

Financial Update

- Financial Summary Reports – June Finance Committee, TPK, and Trinity Burke. Treasurer Don Foy, supported by Marsha Foos, reported on:
 - a) Truro Operating Budget and restricted income updates.
 - b) Monthly expenses, flood repair progress, and overall cash reserves.
 - c) Insurance claim status regarding building flood repairs.
 - d) Capital maintenance priorities, noting the steeple air handler as the top priority for the year.
 - e) Finance Committee approval for launching the Truro Recital Series.
 - f) TPK's strong financial health and cash reserves.
 - g) Trinity Burke's monthly finances and progress toward managing their independent accounts by September.
- The Vestry moved, seconded, and approved acceptance of the financial reports.
- Jamie led the vestry in a brief prayer of thanks for God's continued financial care.

Introduction

- a) Jamie introduced David Reed, candidate for the role of Chancellor Coadjutor, while expressing deep gratitude to outgoing Chancellor Randy Bowen for his many years of faithful service. David shared his testimony and background in legal leadership, expressing joy in stepping into this new role.
- b) Jamie and vestry members paused to pray for both men, giving thanks for Randy's dedicated service and asking for discernment and spiritual strength for David's upcoming leadership.

Business

- a) A Decision Brief was presented by Randy Bowen to appoint David Reed as Chancellor Coadjutor. The Vestry voted to approve.
- b) An Information Brief was presented by Jeff Davidson on Vestry bylaws regarding voting procedures.
- c) An Information Brief was presented by Steve Weagraff to update the vestry on the personnel committee and future plans to expand committee membership.
- d) A Decision Brief was presented by Debbie Hatfield to appoint Angela Weston to the Outreach Committee. The Vestry voted to approve.
- e) An Information Brief was presented by Nancy Gordon on the status of the Undercroft flooring and Parish Office carpet replacement project.

Officer and Other Reports

- a) Senior Warden - No report submitted.
- b) Rector's Report - Jamie briefed his upcoming vacation schedule for August.
